



Application Process

The Calhoun County Emergency Management Agency is limited in the number of interns it can have each semester. Therefore the process for an internship is competitive. Each student that wishes to become an intern will have to follow the this process:

- **Step 1:** Student will need to fill out the application and e-mail it and a copy of their resume to :

- **Step 2:** The Calhoun County EMA will conduct in-person interviews.
- **Step 3:** The Calhoun County EMA will let all applicants know if they have been accepted into the internship program.

Deadline for applications and resume submittals are:

- If applying for a Fall semester Internship: **The first week of June**
- If applying for a Spring Semester Internship: **The third week of December.**
- If applying for a Summer Semester Internship: **The second week of April.**
